

UNFOLDING THE HISTORY



ABOUT TOKLA TEA

Nepal is renowned for its breathtaking natural beauty and diverse environment. One of its most prized treasures is the tea gardens located in the foothills of the Kanchenjunga mountain range in the eastern region. The first tea plantation in Nepal was established in 1863 AD by Colonel Gajaraj Singh Thapa, Governor General of Eastern Nepal, who used seeds gifted by the Chinese Emperor. In 1966 AD, the Nepal Tea Development Corporation was formed, which included seven tea estates. In 2000 AD, the Government of Nepal privatized the tea estates and handed them over to the Triveni Group.

Today, this company oversees all seven tea estates, including two that were originally planted by Colonel Gajaraj Singh Thapa in 1863, and five tea estates established through British technical collaboration around 35 years ago.





THE COMPANY OF SEVEN GARDENS

Ilam Tea Estate - A Pioneer in Quality

At an altitude of 4500-5000 ft. above sea level and spanning 50 acres of land, the llam Tea Estate is renowned for its exceptional tea, known as "The taste of the Himalayas." Established in 1863 AD by then Prime Minister Junga Bahadur Rana, the estate used Chinese tea seeds gifted by the Chinese Emperor's court.

Today, llam Tea has earned a reputation as a household name in Nepal and has a loyal following worldwide. Under the ownership and supervision of the Triveni Group, the llam brand of tea is celebrated for its distinctive flavors and briskness, producing 30 thousand kgs of green tea.

Kanyam Tea Estate - Queen of all Tea Gardens

Sitting at an altitude of 5500 ft, The Queen of Tea Gardens is renowned for its exceptional tea, known for its high quality both in Nepal and internationally. The garden was established with a vision to boost the Nepalese tea sector by Late King Birendra Bir Bikram Shah, using British technical collaboration. Covering an area of around 216 hectares, with 200 hectares dedicated to tea cultivation, the Kanyam Tea Garden produces approximately 2,50,000 kgs of the most exquisite tea.

Tokla Tea Estate - Producing the Best when it Matters most

Established by the British Government in 1974 AD, the estate produces the finest quality CTC tea in Nepal. With a gross area of 336 hectares, approximately 300 hectares are currently dedicated to tea cultivation by Tokla. The estate produces around 2.5 million kgs of CTC tea, maintaining its reputation as a leading producer of high-quality tea.

Chilingkot Tea Estate - Tea Oasis in the Heart of the Jungle

Geographically situated at the foothills of the Mahabharata range, the tea Estate offers the finest quality of CTC tea. This mystical garden has a distinct Liquor and flavor, creating a unique identity and brand that sets it apart from others. Spread over 155 hectares of land, the estate produces half a million kgs of premium CTC tea, while also utilizing 132 hectares for rubber plantations, optimizing space usage.

Burne Tea Estate - Brewing Uniquely Nepalese Tea on Exotic Topsoil

Nestled amidst hills and plains, the sprawling tea estate covers an area of 300 hectares and yields both CTC and orthodox tea of unparalleled quality. The estate is positioned in a region between verdant hills and the expansive plains of the terai belt, which features nutrient-rich soil that contributes to the growth of lush bushes stretching as far as the eye can see. This exceptional terrain imbues the tea with an aroma that tantalizes the taste buds of even the most discerning tea connoisseur.





Baradasi Tea Estate - Taming the Wilderness for Tea Plantation

The Bardasi tea garden, spanning 102 hectares of lush green plantation, is renowned for its ability to cultivate tea in the midst of wild and perilous surroundings. Its remarkable history of establishment is a testament to the efforts and sacrifices made to bring this garden to life.

Soktim Tea Estate - Trailblazing Tea Garden

Situated at an altitude of 1000-3000 ft, the tea estate is a significant producer of CTC tea. Referred to as the "llam's Annexes," it is one of the oldest tea estates in Nepal, having been established in 1865 AD as an extension of the llam Tea Estate. Colonel Thapa had initially planted the llam Tea Estate, and the annexes were planted as a successful offshoot. Approximately 20% of the garden is covered with pure Chinese Seeds, and it spans over 66 hectares.

Tokla CTC, grown in the gardens of Jhapa, is a mild and refreshing tea suitable for daily use. It is made using the Crush, Tear, Curl method and is known for providing the best quality tea with the originality of Nepalese CTC.


